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Description:

Pre Calculus is Math course that continues the Algebraic analysis of polynomial functions. We will also study exponential, logarithmic and trigonometric functions. Graphing calculators can be very useful and are recommended.

Quizzes/Tests/Final:

- Quizzes will be worth around 15 points and be given every week or so. Quizzes may be retaken for the full amount of credit possible within a week.
- Tests will be worth around 50 points and be given every few weeks. Tests may be retaken for a maximum of 70%. Tests must be retaken prior to the date of the next exam.
- One final, comprehensive exam will be given at the end of each term. Every student will be required to take the final exam. The final will be worth 15% of the final, trimester grade.

Assignments:

Assignments will consist of individual and group homework or class work. Work will generally be assigned every class period and will usually be due the following class meeting. Assignments will customarily be worth 5 points and graded from 0 - 5 points. Longer assignments will be worth more. Late work will be graded for 1/2 credit. Students with unexcused absences will not be allowed to make up missed work. Assignments will be checked or handed in to the appropriate upper tray, on the table, at the side of the room. They will be returned, graded in the lower tray.

Test Make Ups:

Students need to schedule quiz and test make ups as soon as possible. Make ups will take place outside of class time and need to be completed prior to the scheduled date of the next test.
